INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH SYNERGY WORKSHOP

(International Collaborative Research Networking Workshop)

1. Background

In September 2024, during the Annual Board Meeting (ABM 2024), key research areas were endorsed for support in the upcoming 14th Call for Proposals. These areas include Health (Infectious Diseases and Immunology), Alternative Energy, and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management. This endorsement reflects a growing recognition of the urgent challenges facing the region, driven by recent crises and adversities.

The ongoing threat of infectious diseases poses not only regional but also global health risks, particularly with the emergence of diseases that have pandemic potential. Additionally, the increasing frequency and severity of natural disasters underscore the urgent need for effective strategies and innovative technologies to manage and mitigate risks. Furthermore, developing renewable energy is crucial for fostering a sustainable energy future that enhances energy security and addresses climate change, which are pressing issues for the region and the world.

In response to these critical challenges, JST from Japan and DOST-PCIEERD from the Philippines, in collaboration with the e-ASIA JRP Secretariat, are organizing the “International Research Synergy Workshop” to facilitate collaborative research initiatives by bringing together researchers to foster innovative solutions and partnerships in these vital areas through research.

2. Purpose

This workshop aims to promote collaborative research in East Asia through building international research teams to apply to the 14th e-ASIA JRP calls on Health, Disaster Risk Reduction and Management and Alternative Energy.

During the Workshop

- **Session 1:** The e-ASIA Joint Research Program Secretariat will provide an overview of the e-ASIA JRP Framework. This session will outline the program's goals and objectives, including multilateral joint research and support.
- **Session 2:** In this session, participating Member Organizations for the 14th Call for Proposals will present their eligibility requirements and national guidelines. Under the multilateral joint research operation, the eligibility requirements for applications vary by country. To enhance your chances of qualifying for the technical review process, we invite you to take advantage of this valuable opportunity by attending this session. You will gain insights into the specific requirements and receive guidance on how to navigate the application process effectively.
- **Session 3:** This session aims to promote international networking and foster collaboration among member organizations and researchers in three research areas: Health (Infectious Diseases and Immunology), Alternative Energy, and Disaster Risk Management. Each research area will be introduced by main member organizations or the Secretariat, followed by Presentation from invited speakers. A discussion will follow the pitch talks to explore cross-border research partnerships and collaborative opportunities.
- **Pitch Talk:** Each pitch talk will be 5 minutes long and may include up to 2 slides, along with registration information. Four participants will be selected per research area. Interested participants should indicate their intent on the registration page and submit the necessary files to the Secretariat by the specified deadline. As the workshop aims to foster connections among researchers for the 14th Call, please ensure your content aligns with this purpose. Selected participants will be notified by November 12 and must submit an additional presentation slide (preferably 1 PPT) by November 18.
