GLS on SDGs (Spring 2022)

Background of the Program:

Guest Lecture Series on SDGs (GLS on SDGs) is a short program hosted by Institut Teknologi Sepuluh Nopember, Indonesia, that is conducted online, held as three series of guest lectures during Spring 2022. Based on the necessity for students to understand Sustainable Development Goals established by United Nations, this program aims to fulfil their needs in comprehending and applying Sustainable Development Goals.

This program will be held on March, May, and June 2022. Each series of GLS on SDGs will focus on three different aspects: (1) Concept & Principle in March 2022, (2) Practice & Policy in May 2022, and (3) Actions in June 2022.

- Material** : UN SDGs 1-17
- Objectives** :
1. Raise awareness on UN sustainable development goals among university students and academia through sharing of knowledge from experts in the form of lecture sessions in key topics from each UN SDGs.
 2. Stimulate ideas from students in relations to sustainable development goals for possible concrete action.
 3. Strengthen partnership among universities participating in the lecture series.

Overall Program Outline:

1. GLS on SDGs Concept and Principle

Lecture contents from speakers:

- Explanation about the objective and significance of SDGs
- Explanation about definitions of SDGs 1-17
- Emphasizing the fundamental that underlining each SDGs 1-17 respectively
- Exploring the key indicator that shapes SSDGs 1-17



2. GLS on SDGs Practice and Policy

Lecture contents from speakers:

- Representing case studies regarding SDGs 1-17
- Implementation of SDGs 1-17 in each speaker's universities/regions/research center
- Review of policy implemented in each speaker's universities/regions/research center

3. GLS on SDGs Actions

Role of student participants:

- Exposing actions that have represented SDGs 1-17 through a poster.
- Creating and implementing project that represents SDGs 1-17 through a poster.
- Submission of the posters will be conducted and will be selected to be presented in GLS on SDGs action.
- Each group presents the SDGs action poster in the scheduled time.
- The best participants will receive rewards (study excursions/CommTECH)
