1. Presentation of INSA Hauts-de-France

INSA Hauts-de-France is one of the 7 Institutes of the INSA group

and

one of the 3 Institutes of Université Polytechnique Hauts-de-France (UPHF)



INSA Group: 13 higher education institutions
7 INSA in France
+ 6 associated schools
22,179 students among them 35% of female
4,649 international students





INSA Hauts-de-France: key figures

- 4900 students,
- More than 300 faculty members,
- 65 technical and administrative staff,
- 13 Master degrees (24 mentions),
- 9 engineer degrees.


