What can be funded?

Doctoral projects (individual or structured programme) at a state-run or state-recognised university or non-university research institute in Germany

Who can apply?

Excellent-qualified young academics and scientists from **most ASEAN countries**, **exception: Brunei Darussalam**, who have completed a Master's degree no longer than **six years** before their application

Requirements

Letter of Acceptance by an academic supervisor at a German university
Research proposal approved by supervisor
Schedule of planned research work (...)

Value

1,200 €/month + additional allowances

Duration of funding

Up to 4 years

Application deadline

October 2024

Research Scholarships for PhD-students and young PostDocs

What can be funded?

Research stays at state or state-recognized institutions of higher education or non-university research institutes in Germany.

Who can apply?

PhD-students: 2-12 months

PostDocs (max. 4 years since PhD): 2-6 months

Requirements

Among other things, application documents contain

- a comprehensive statement about research project
- letter from host in Germany confirming academic cooperation, which refers to the applicant's proposal
- proof of relevant language knowledge

Value

Monthly allowance of 1,300 Euro, travel allowance, insurance, etc.

Application deadline

7th October and 3rd April

Study Scholarships for STEM disciplines (Master)

What can be funded?

a Master's degree in STEM subjects
a graduate degree leading, or a complementary course that does not lead to support the qualification and employability of young academics and future professionals at a state or state-recognised German university of your choice

Who can apply?

graduates (last degree not older than 6 years) from Indonesia and Malaysia

Language requirements

depend on the chosen study programme

Benefits

monthly scholarship rate (992 euros)
travel allowance
insurance
course must be free of tuition fees

Application deadline

20 October

What can be funded?

Individual scholarships for certain Postgraduate courses in Germany listed

Who can apply?

Graduates with at least **2 years' professional experience** in most ASEAN countries, **exception:** Brunei Darussalam & Singapore.

depend on the chosen study programme

12 to 36 months

Objectives

to enhance the qualification of potential “**change makers**” / specialists from developing countries

Who can apply?

graduates with a first degree in **law, politics, economics, social sciences or administration**; **work experience is not required** from **most ASEAN countries**, **exception**: Brunei Darussalam & Singapore.

What can be funded?

individual scholarships for **specific postgraduate courses**

Language requirements

depend on chosen study programme

Duration of funding

12 to 36 months (depends on study programme)

Application deadline

1 June – 31 July

Research Stays for University Academics and Scientists

What can be funded?

Research stays at state or state-recognized institutions of higher education or non-university research institutes in Germany.

Who can apply?

University teachers and scientists, who work at a university or research institutions and usually already hold a doctoral degree

Requirements

- ❖ Online application form
- ❖ Full curriculum vitae in tabular form (max. 3 pages)
- ❖ List of academic publications (max. 3 pages)
- ❖ Comprehensive statement about research project (max. 10 pages)
- ❖ Time schedule
- ❖ Letter from host confirming academic cooperation, which refers to the applicant's proposal and guarantees that a workplace will be provided

Value

Monthly allowance of at least 2,000 Euro, travel allowance, insurance

Duration of funding

1-3 months

Application deadline

5th October and 3rd April

DAAD Re-invitation Program

What can be funded?

- Research and working projects at state or state-recognized institutions of higher education or non-university research institutes in Germany.
- Working stays at an institution in business, administration, culture or media for former scholarship holders who work outside the science sector.

Who can apply?

- former holder of DAAD research grants or study scholarships and funding was provided by the Federal Foreign Office for a period of over six months.
- former East German scholarship holder who studied for at least one year in Germany.

Requirements

Online application form, CV, list of publication, research proposal, time schedule, confirmation/ invitation from the German host institution

Value

Monthly allowance of at least 2,000 Euro, travel allowance, insurance

Duration of funding

1-3 months

Application deadline

5th October and 3rd April
