

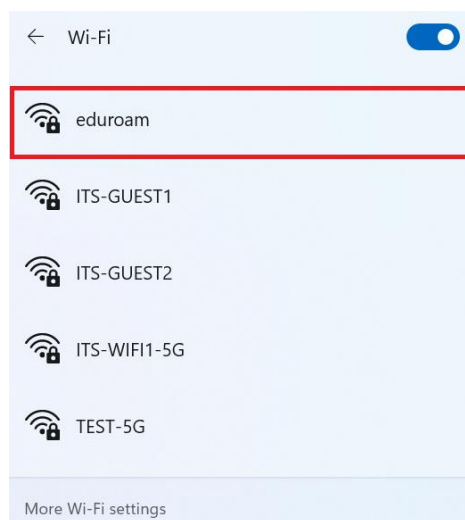

WINDOWS 10/11 Connections

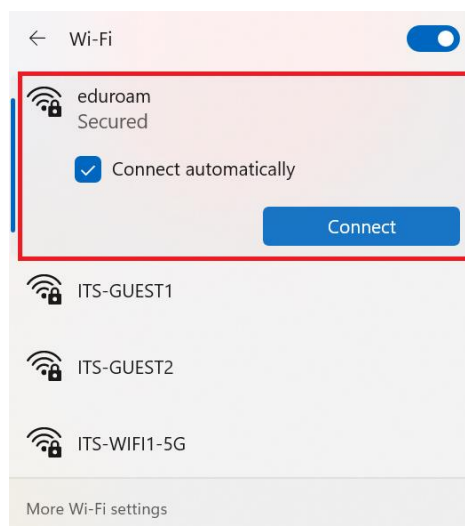
1. Select the wireless network icon  or **Network and Connection Setting** in the bottom right corner of the screen.



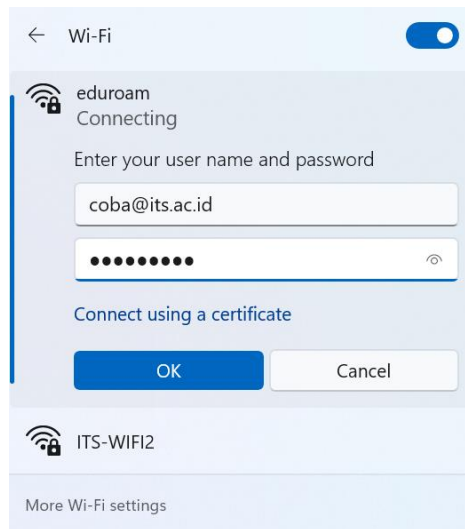
2. Select **eduroam** from the list of available wireless networks.



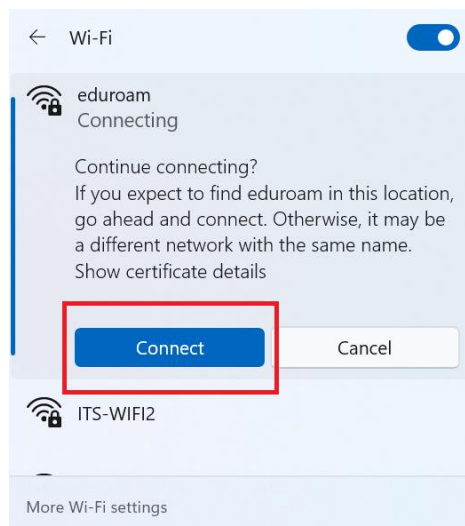
3. Select **Connect automatically**, then click **Connect** to connect computer to Wi-Fi.



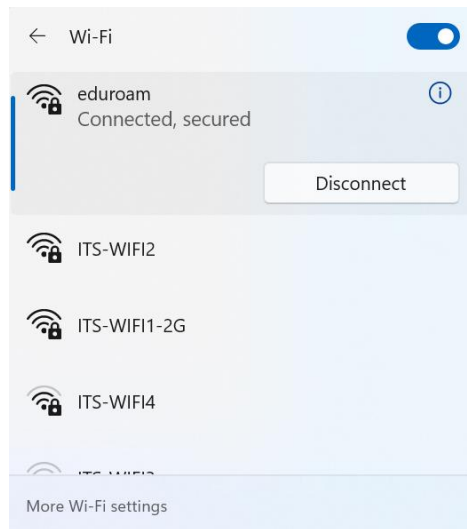
4. A login page will appear, enter your personal institution **username** and **password**. For ITS stakeholder, use your **ITS email address** and your **myITS password** to login.

6. Wait until **eduroam** status changes to **Connected**. Try browsing an outside campus website to ensure your internet connection is successful.



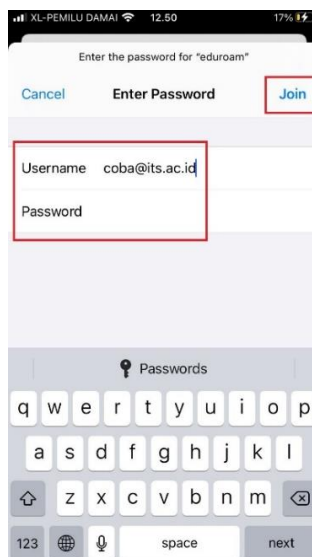

IPHONE Connections

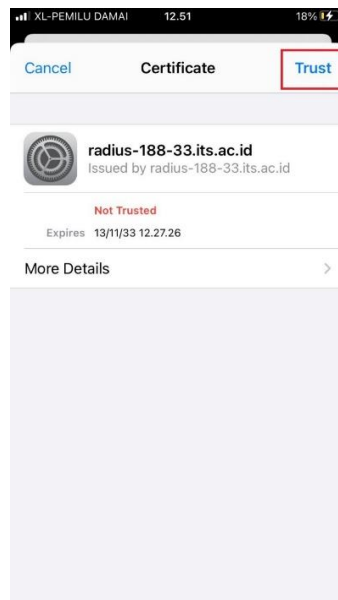
1. Turn-on the Wi-Fi and select **eduroam**.

4. If the **blue check mark** show up at the **eduroam** SSID, it means your connection is successful.



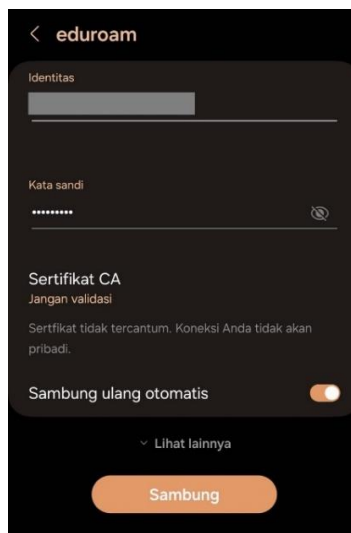

ANDROID Connections

1. Turn-on the Wi-Fi and select **eduroam**.



2. Enter your **personal institution username** on identity column, then enter the **password**. For ITS stakeholder, enter your **ITS email address** and **myITS password**. Select **Don't validate** to verify the **Certificate**. Turn-on the **Connect automatically**, then click **Connect**.
